## License Information for Commercial Fishing Vessels, Tenders, Processors and Transporters

Commercial fishing vessels, tenders or packers, processors and transporters must be licensed by the Commercial Fisheries Entry Commission. Vessels used **solely** for harvesting salmon at set net sites or in state waters between the latitudes of Point Romanof and Cape Newenham and surrounding Nunivak Island are exempt as set out in AS 16.05.495.

The vessel license fee is based upon the United States Coast Guard definition of overall length of the vessel, 46USC2101(20b) "overall in length" means (A) for a foreign vessel or a vessel engaged on a foreign voyage, the greater of (i) 96 percent of the length on a waterline at 85 percent of the least molded depth measured from top of the keel (or on a vessel designed with a rake of keel, on a waterline parallel to the designed waterline: or (ii) the length from the fore side of the stem to the axis of the rudder stock on that water line; and (B) for any other vessel, the horizontal distance of the hull between the foremost part of the stem and the aftermost part of the stern, excluding fittings and attachments".

The vessel license consists of a triangular metal ADFG number plate issued when the vessel is first licensed with the Commercial Fisheries Entry Commission, as well as a printed vessel license receipt and sticker, issued annually. If the vessel is registered for salmon net fishing, the license may also include a salmon net area tab. Once registered for a salmon net area, in subsequent years a new area tab will be issued only if the area is changed or if requested.

USCG documentation or State registration is required for all motorized vessels used in commercial fishing activities. The United States Coast Guard assigns Official Documentation numbers to vessels measuring at least 5 net tons, generally 32' or longer. Vessels under 5 net tons are assigned registration numbers, 'AK' numbers in Alaska, from the DMV. For applications or information on registering boats under 5 net tons in Alaska call 1-907-269-5551. For assistance with documentation of vessels 5 net tons or over call 1-800-799-8362.

**Salmon Fishing Vessels:** Seiners, drift gillnetters and trollers must be registered by completing the net area and/or troll registration sections in the Vessel Information section. Once the vessel is licensed for the current year, changes to salmon net area or troll registration must be requested on a *Vessel License Change of Information* form.

**Changes of Ownership:** May be reported to the Entry Commission in two ways. 1) If the vessel is not licensed for the current year, the new owner may complete the *Vessel License Application*. This will license the vessel for the current year as well as change the ownership. 2) If the vessel it is already licensed for the current year, complete a *Vessel License Change of Information* form and submit it with the current year's Vessel License Receipt.

**Lost or Damaged** metal ADFG number plates, vessel license receipts, vessel triangle stickers and salmon net area tabs may be replaced by submitting the appropriate fee with a *Request for Duplicate License* form.
