



Commercial Fisheries Entry Commission 2023 Permit and Vessel Renewal Information

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PERMIT & VESSEL INFORMATION

All permits & vessels you renewed for 2022 are pre-printed on your renewal form.

Permits:

If you did not renew your Limited Entry permit for the previous year, the past year fee must be paid before the current year fees can be paid. Any past year fees due are listed below the permit information on your renewal form. Please check the space for each permit you wish to renew and check the space if you intend to fish. If you do not intend to fish the permit, the card will not be issued.

Vessels:

Please check the box for each vessel you wish to renew. If you have multiple vessels they will be printed on the back of your renewal form.

Salmon Net Area:

If the vessel is used for salmon seining or gillnetting, the registration section is pre-printed with the salmon net area and permits that you provided in 2022. If you wish to change this, please do so by crossing off the salmon net area and permit numbers and providing the new area and permit numbers.

Salmon Troll:

If the vessel is used for salmon trolling, the pre-printed registration date is derived from the 2022 date that you registered to start trolling. If you wish to change your date, please do so by crossing out the date and writing in the date you wish to register.

PAYMENT INFORMATION

Types of Payment Accepted:

We encourage you to renew online at www.cfec.state.ak.us, however, payment may be submitted by check, money order or the attached credit card authorization via US mail.

Nonresidents:

There is a requirement to pay the nonresident differential of \$190.00 on the first permit renewed for 2023. This fee applies to permit fees only.

Poverty Reduced Permit Fee:

To apply for the poverty reduced permit fee, you must complete a *2023 Federal Income Guidelines and Reduced Fee Permit Application* and submit it with the required documents which are listed on the application. Poverty fee applies to permit fees only.

RESIDENCY & CITIZENSHIP

Residency Status:

If you claim Alaska residency, you must complete the "Residency Information" section of the attached "Commercial Fishing Permit Application" form. Failure to do so may result in a nonresident fee differential being charged to your account.

Citizenship Status:

If you are a resident alien, please write your alien registration number and include a copy of your green card or work authorization card.

Signature and Date:

The application must be signed and dated in order for CFEC to renew your licenses. Authorization must be attached if signed or picked-up by someone else.

ADDRESS, PHONE & EMAIL ADDRESS

Permanent Mailing Address:

Please make sure that your permanent mailing address is correct. If it has changed, check the box and write the new address.

Physical Address:

Please provide the physical location of your residence (this is where you live) and the years and months at this location.

Phone Number and Email Address:

Having your current phone number and email address is important so our licensing staff can contact you if there is a problem processing your 2023 renewal.
